Navy Yank Texas: The Dance Model

In 1861-1862 the J.H. Dance & Brothers started their revolver production. Probably inspired by the most renowned models at that time, the 1848 Dragoon and the 1851 Navy, they designed the Dance revolver.

The Spiller & Burr model combines the merits of two famous revolvers: the Remington solid frame and the Colt mechanism.
